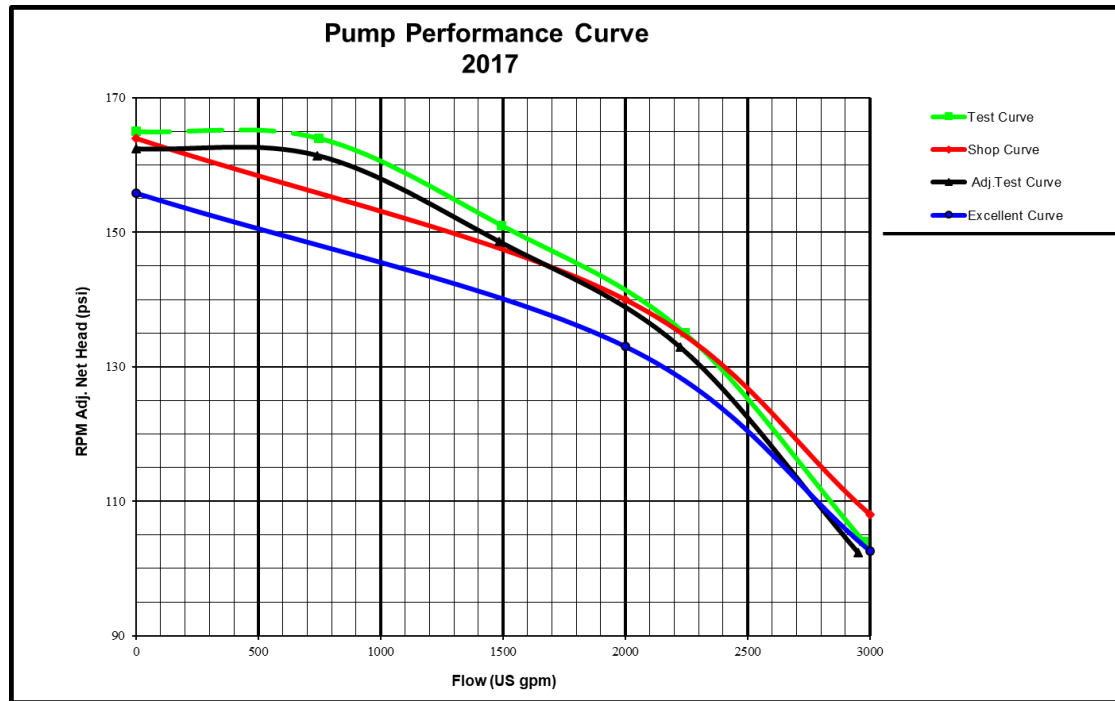
- * How much high pressure water can the fire protection water system supply at remote areas?
